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Short Biography:

Alvaro began his career in graphic design but soon shifted to time-based mediums allowing an unfolding of ideas in real time and space. Pursuing filmic interests, he became an art director for short fringe films. Having passed through graphics, film-making, model-making, animation and religious sculpture, in architecture he found an area that could encompass all previous roads travelled.

His architectural education - at the Architectural Association in London in the mid-nineties - circled around deconstructivist methods and 20th Century French philosophical influences. Through this he acquired a healthy disbelief for inherited architectural and political agendas. This was carried forward into his teaching where his pedagogical approach attempts to playfully undermine existing academic hegemony in the hope of "airing more minor voices". His academic role has been to motivate and tease-out tentative ideas from learners, materializing their experiences.

Alvaro has been working professionally in Bangkok on research and commercial architecture for both private and Governmental Institutions at the Research and Design Service Centre (REDEK). His own freelance work invites an interdisciplinary approach best exemplified through recent collaborations with Takuya Onishi of Energy Meet resulting in installations incorporating robotics and solar power. He has recently opened a learning laboratory using experimental pedagogical methods and learning techniques - a space in which ideas can gain significance in the hope of taking affect beyond the classroom.

Alvaro has been working in Bangkok Thailand since 2003 and currently lectures at King Mongkut's University.

Practice & Research Areas:

The dynamic relationship between pedagogy and practice informs Alvaro's research interests. With over ten years of teaching, he continues to pursue conditions for the emergence of new techniques, augmenting and undermining existing educational perspectives. "The more you learn the more you must humble yourself in order to allow more minor voices to exist and emerge...any real learning environment would allow the emergence of other fragile voices to compete with inherited strategies disclosing additional fertile ground". His interest lies in teasing out initial 'architectural courage' proffered by students, allowing tentative ideas to come into existence and flourish. Mobilizing such forces allows teaching to dissolve. More often than not, the unmotivated find fascination, prior expectations are shed, student awareness catalyzes into credible work and ideas gain significance beyond classroom boundaries. As educator, Alvaro continues to monitor, evaluate, accept and reject educational strategies in order to allow students to develop their own.
